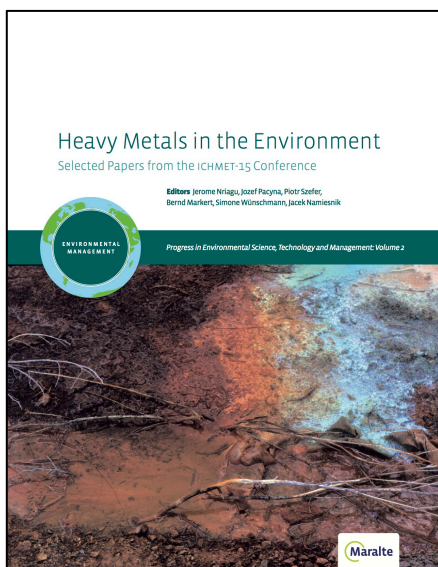

Although there are workshops, conferences and symposia on many metals – from arsenic to zinc – the International Conference on Heavy Metals in the Environment (ICHMET) remains the only forum that provides an integrated perspective on research, technology and management of all heavy metals in a trans-disciplinary context. Scientists need to understand not only the unique features and behavior of individual heavy metals but also the differences, similarities and interactions of different metals at the ecosystem, systemic and cellular levels if we are to deal with the problems of heavy metal pollution at the local, regional and global levels in a sustainable manner.

The 15th International Conference on Heavy Metals in the Environment (ICHMET-15) was held from September 19 to 23, 2010 at the Gdańsk University of Technology, Poland.
